

Directions for Completing the Women to Women
University Scholarship Application



Women to Women Group awards university scholarship once a year. Interviews are held only in March each year with awards announced the first week of April.

Women to Women Scholarships are competitive due to the volume of requests for financial assistance. **Not every applicant will be interviewed; not every applicant will receive an award.** All applicants are evaluated in four areas: academic performance/ financial need/leadership qualities/benefit to community. The Scholarship Committee may visit the home before deciding awards.

Criteria to be eligible: Students must be a resident of Jaltemba Bay area and attended public high school (Conalep or La Penita Prepa); not more than age 30; have outstanding grades 8.5 or higher; show leadership qualities; demonstrate financial need; and she must be currently enrolled or accepted into a recognized post-secondary institution for the upcoming academic year. Awards are given for one academic year but can be renewed for an additional 4 years until graduation.

Your request application will not be considered unless it includes **ALL** of the following items.

1. A fully completed application p 2 form that includes student current contact info: Facebook, Whatsapp, cell, and email.
2. An official transcript of your latest grade report:
3. Current photo: it can be from Facebook or other informal source.
4. A copy of your scheduled date for the university admission test. If you are already attending university, include your most recent university grades.
5. Two letters of recommendation that explaining why you qualify for an award. References must include your principal and the other recommendation a non-relative. Both letters should describe your personality, assess your abilities and achievements..
6. Submit an essay in Spanish **and** English that explains your educational objectives. This paragraph is your chance to dazzle the committee with your dreams and goals. We want to know you as an individual; tell us how attaining an education will change your life.
7. Include a copy of the University Curriculum/ Plan de Estudio that lists the required courses and social service for your degree program as well as the number of years until graduation.
